Community Outreach

Part of the Emerge Gallery & Art Center's mission is to make the arts accessible to the entire community. For every five paid programs, one is completely free and targeted towards at-risk or disadvantaged youth. We do this through art programs geared towards those affected by cancer in the hospital, artist in residency programs, and our Youth Arts Initiative program, which includes scholarships and our Youth Public Arts Project.

Youth Public Arts Project is our longest running outreach program. Started in 2005, this is a bi-monthly program, where at-risk youth come to the arts council to work with professional artists and musicians to create various public art projects and learn about the rich heritage of African American music. The public art is then displayed throughout the community.

Art is Good Medicine is an arts in healthcare program in partnership with local healthcare providers Vidant Health. Professional visual artists and dancers work with adult and pediatric cancer patients and survivors. In addition, we facilitate weekly art experiences at Hope Lodge and offer free workshops to cancer patients, survivors, family members, and caregivers.

Scholarships are offered to disadvantaged children in our community to attend classes and workshops free of charge.

Payment & Refund Policies

- Payments must be made in full. Deposits are not accepted!
- There will be NO refunds (full or partial) after five days prior to a class.
- Full refunds are available up to two weeks in advance, minus the processing fee of \$20.
- Full refunds must be requested in writing via mail, in person, or via email to paula@emergegallery.com.
- Partial Refunds are available after two weeks on a sliding scale up to five days prior to class and include the deduction of the processing fee of \$20.

The scale of what Emerge Gallery & Art Center will retain if a cancellation occurs:

- 12 13 days prior 10% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 10 11 days prior 20% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 8 9 days prior 30% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 7 days prior 40% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 6 days prior 50% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- 5 days prior 60% of enrollment plus the \$20 processing fee
- After 5 days prior no refund is given
- In the case of emergency, sickness, or similar events, please contact Paula Rountree at Emerge Gallery & Art Center concerning your situation and need of a refund. Each situation is examined on an individual basis. Decisions are made by the Education Committee.
- In the event of any refund, the Emerge Gallery & Art Center will retain a \$20 processing fee.
- Emerge Gallery & Art Center does not offer makeup classes in any form for classes missed due to no fault of our organization. This includes switching classes or sessions.

COVID Class Guidelines & Refund Policies

- There will be temperature checks at the beginning of each class.
- All students, instructors, and staff are required to wear a face mask. We will have some available for purchase or you may pack your own.
- We encourage you to dress for mess. To reduce sharing items, Emerge Gallery & Art Center will not be able to provide aprons.
- We encourage you to pack your own apron or wear clothes you are ok with getting art on.
- The in-person class size has been reduced to 4-5 students depending on classroom size.
- Emerge Gallery & Art Center will offer a Zoom option for a few of the classes. Students must have their own supplies (except for clay, that would have to be purchased through Emerge Gallery & Art Center with contactless pick up).
- The in-person class and Zoom class are not interchangeable.
- Emerge Gallery & Art Center asks that if anyone in your household is sick or showing signs of becoming sick, that you do not attend class.
- If someone is sick or showing signs, please let us know and Emerge Gallery & Art Center will issue a refund for any unused class time.



DAYTIME POTTER'S WHEEL

This is the perfect class for those interested in learning and perfecting throwing on the potter's wheel. Intro students will learn the basics of wheel throwing while intermediate and advanced students will work with the instructor on problem solving and refining their skills. Through this process you can maintain a clean wheel thrown finish or you can finish with a textured hand-built surface. We will then decorate our surface with underglazes, slips, and glazes to create truly unique vases! Just in time to have your vase ready for fresh spring flowers! Bring your creativity or just a photo of Aunt Joe and we can get your home ready for Spring planting! [Min. 4, Max. 5] Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project. Want to sweeten up your kitchen with a new personalized sugar jar?! In this class we will make custom kitchen storage containers. From butter dishes to cookie jars, let's get creative! We will work with hump molds, slabs, and coil building methods, and create lavish surfaces with texture, inlay, and relief techniques. [Min. 4, Max. 5] Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project. Supply fees for all ceramics classes are \$20 per bag of clay and \$20 for the required toolkit. INTRO TO WHEEL THROWING

If you've never tried the potter's wheel but have always wanted to, then this class is for you. If you've thrown on the wheel before but need a refresher or are new to Emerge, then this class is for you too! During this introductory class, you will learn the fundamentals necessary for throwing cylinders and bowls. The session will focus on techniques for centering, opening, pulling, trimming, and glazing; and, by the end of the session, students will have several finished pots to take home. Class size is restricted so students can get the technical instruction required to establish a good foundation for continued learning. This class is a prerequisite for continuing pottery classes. [Min./Max. 4] Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project.

Supply fees for all ceramics classes are \$20 per bag of clay and \$20 for the required toolkit. All glazes and firing are included.

CONTINUING POTTER: BEYOND THE BASICS

Continuing students will hone their skills at centering, opening, and pulling during this 6 week class. Projects are designed to help improve the fundamentals necessary for crafting advanced cylinders and bowls. Advanced skills such as increasing scale, pulling spouts, and attaching handles will be addressed to challenge potters who have more wheel experience. Each project will include glazing and surface decoration discussions. This class is project driven and will allow students to take home several functional pieces! Introduction to Wheel Throwing is a prerequisite to this class. [Min. 4, Max. 5] Ages 16 and up or by special permission for senior project.

Supply fees for all ceramics classes are \$20 per bag of clay and \$20 for the required toolkit. All glazes and firing are included.

Learn metalsmithing techniques such as sawing, filing, soldering, and riveting to make a variety of projects. First-time participants will make a bracelet that involves all of these basic methods. Returning participants will work with the instructor to problem solve, refine their basic skills, and explore more advanced techniques such as enameling, etching, alternative materials, and stone setting.
